

RED, WHITE, & WHO?

Game Rules

Red, White, & Who? is a famous American figure guessing game. To play you must first select as many famous historical figures from the United States that you want to include in your game. The more players you have and how long you want to play will help you determine how many figures you need to have picked out ahead of time.

Use the template provided to list the name of the historical figure and the answers to the clues. Choose figures who have clear answers available for each clue. If there is more than one answer for a clue, list all of them.

You can play as individuals or divide up into teams. If you use teams then one person will have to be the moderator/clue-giver for the entire game. If you play as individuals then the moderator can rotate so everyone has a chance.

The game starts with one person providing the first clue for an individual. The other players will guess if they wish. It is not a free for all with people yelling out their guesses. Instead have players raise their hand (or if available, have them raise small American flags!) and wait to be called upon. If they are incorrect, move on to the next person willing to guess until either the correct answer is given or everyone has had one guess. Then reveal the answer to the next hint and repeat the process.

Points are assigned based on the number of clues that have been given:

- 1 clue: 5 points
- 2 clues: 4 points
- 3 clues: 3 points
- 4 clues: 2 points
- 5 clues: 1 point

You can play to a certain amount of points, or play until all the historical figures have been guessed.
